Please note I am looking for copies of, among other things, any and all solicitations, proposals submitted by potential vendors and documents related to RedSpeed and its possible interest in becoming a vendor.
- + Copies of any and all correspondence, including but not Ilmited to emails, between David Stachura, since his arrival on the school board, and Roy McCampbell. This should include emails sent to or from personal email addresses to the extent they pertain to School District business.
